This position will work closely with both the Supervisor Greyhound Authorised officers, GM Animal Welfare, the stewards department and the investigations unit and will conduct kennel and property inspections across the state ensuring the industry participants involved in all stages of the Greyhound's lifecycle are aware of their responsibilities and meet both GRV and other Legislative requirements
