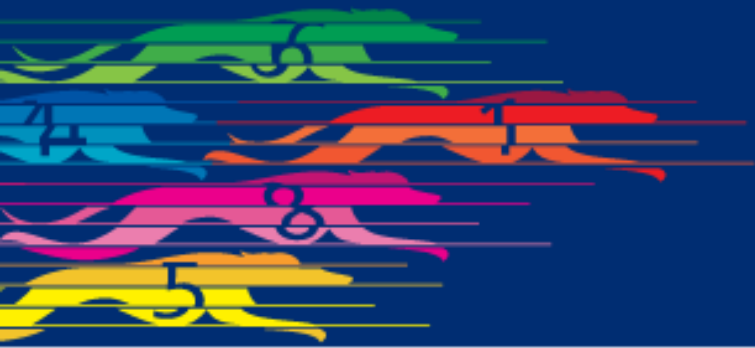
WHAT: Greyhound Community Day, featuring a crowd of pet greyhounds and their owners.
