Offence:	The greyhound 'Jeff Hunt' did fail to pursue the lure with due commitment at an event by reason of injury.

REPORT:

The GRV RADB received an Appeal lodged by Mr. Alan Hunter against a decision handed down by the Greyhound Racing Victoria Stewards at Sale on Thursday, 27 February 2014.

The Stewards determined, under the provisions of Greyhounds Australasia Rule 69 B(1)(a), that the greyhound 'Jeff Hunt' failed to pursue the lure with due commitment by reason of injury during Event 12 at Sale on Thursday, 27 February 2014. Subsequently, under GAR 69 B(1)(a), 'Jeff Hunt' was ordered to undergo a satisfactory trial pursuant to GAR72.

Mr. Alan Hunter represented himself at the RADB hearing.

Mr. Glenn Fish (GRV Chief Steward) and Mr. Ron Matthews represented the Stewards Panel.

After hearing all the evidence tendered, the RADB determined that the greyhound 'Jeff Hunt' did fail to pursue the lure with due commitment by reason of injury and the appeal was dismissed. The nature of the greyhound's injury is not a relevant issue under GAR 69 B(1)(a).
