REPORT

Stewards on the 6th March 2014 conducted an inquiry into the circumstances in which the greyhound Saint Propelled had failed to be scratched from its engagement in Race 9 at the Bendigo Greyhound Racing Club on the 28th January 2014.

After hearing the evidence, Stewards charged Mr Giles with a breach of GAR86 (o) in that as the trainer of Saint Propelled, he did fail to scratch the greyhound from its engagement at the Bendigo Greyhound Racing Club meeting; an act which in the opinion of stewards was negligent.

Mr Giles pleaded guilty to the charge.

Stewards found Mr Giles guilty as charged and fined him the sum of \$300, with \$150 of this fine wholly suspended for 12 months pending no further breaches of the rule.
