Greyhound Racing Victoria commemorates Anzac Day

GREYHOUND Racing Victoria and its clubs will again show their support for the RSL and its local branches as Anzac Day fast approaches.

For the second year in a row GRV will donate \$10,000 to the RSL's Anzac Day Appeal while all clubs will make a \$1000 donation to their local branch.

Select clubs, including The Meadows, Warragul, Geelong, Traralgon, Sale, Cranbourne, Horsham and Ballarat will also host a function for RSL members to honour the anniversary.

Last year, GRV hosted the Red Dog Run campaign which raised \$12,000 for the Anzac Day Appeal.

In addition to its financial contribution, GRV has also invited RSL volunteers to race meetings during the week of Anzac Day to sell badges and raise further funds.

GRV and its clubs have also encouraged the RSL to use club facilities for meetings and other functions.
