GRV to appeal RADB decision on Moore penalty

Greyhound Racing Victoria (GRV) Stewards will seek a review of the decision of the independent Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Board (RADB) in relation to the penalty imposed on registered trainer Mr Dallas Moore on 12 September 2015.

Mr Moore was charged by GRV Stewards and found guilty by the RADB of failing to present the greyhound 'Startin To Shake' free of any prohibited substance for an event at Bendigo Greyhound Racing Club on Wednesday 27 May 2015.

The RADB determined that Mr Moore be fined \$500 and disqualified for a period of 3 months but such disqualification to be wholly suspended for 12 months subject to no further breach of Greyhound Australasia Rules 79A and 83.

The Stewards are seeking a review on the grounds that the penalty imposed was too lenient and that the disqualification period should not have been wholly suspended.
