She has more genuine early speed than her opponent, so she is expected to gain a clear passage throughout. Look Fancy Nancy is the value runner in the race, she finally put it altogether at Bendigo last time and she posted a quick personal time here when placed behind the race favourite on the 15th of August. He Shall Power rounds out the chances, he has class on his side and has been sharpened with three 600m hit outs here in recent weeks.

MATCHDOG Great line-up and there won't be a lot separating them in the end, however Catch The Thief should be able to pounce on the lead in his match up and if he reproduces something similar to his performance last week he should get the cash. Christo Bale will get a great run behind the Thief and that will allow him to post his fastest possible time and that may be enough for him to grab second place overall. Aston Wizard is the value in the series, if he can find a length or so in the run to the 1st marker, he will be able to put up an extremely fast overall time.
