The Greyhound Racing Integrity Unit (GRIU) Stewards Panel is key in upholding the integrity of the industry through ensuring transparent and fair conduct of racing.

About the Opportunity

We are looking for highly motivated individuals to join the GRIU Stewards Panel.

The primary purpose of the role is to uphold the integrity of the industry. GRV Stewards are responsible for race meetings being conducted in accordance with the Rules of Racing and GRV policies and guidelines for participants. You may be part of a race day team or, in charge, chairing the race meeting. Race meetings are conducted at 13 clubs across Victoria.

Stewards also assist with investigating incidents and potential breaches of the Rules of Racing. This includes assisting with inquiries conducted by the Victorian Racing Tribunal (VRT) and at appeals to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT). The role requires flexible working with a combination of day, afternoon, evening, and weekend shifts determined by the GRV race meeting schedule.

About You

We are seeking candidates who has:

- demonstrated interpersonal and customer service skills
- skills and experience in coordinating the work of others and providing clear direction
- a strong appreciation of the importance of rules and regulations and an affinity for compliance
- a Victorian driver's licence.
- Certificate IV Racing Services (Stewards) or willingness to complete within the first 12 months a good understanding of the racing industry (desirable)
- sound MS Office skills and the ability to prepare standard reports.
