Sportsbet Melbourne Cup Heats: Armchair guide

The 2023 \$4.1m Sportsbet *Dream Chasers Festival* is the world's richest greyhound series.

And the 2023 \$1.008m Group 1 Sportsbet Melbourne Cup – carrying a \$650,000 first prize on December 2 – is the world's greatest greyhound race.

So, naturally, you would expect the Melbourne Cup heats (515m) – Night 3 of the *DCF's* five massive nights of elite greyhound racing and entertainment – to be possibly the best quality night of racing in the world.

Well, ponder the following facts and figures as 64 of Australia's premier sprinters go "marching as one on the road to the holy grail".

Yes, "it's one hell of a story"!

On a cumulative basis, the Melbourne Cup aspirants have amassed a staggering **806** wins from **2381** starts (a 34% strike rate) with – get this – **\$11,596,762** in prizemoney – and **11** Group 1 trophies on the mantelpiece!

Further, Sportsbet's early betting market is dominated by six superstars.

Amazingly, three are trained by four-time Melbourne Cup winner Jason Thompson – **Alpha Zulu** (\$6), **Flying Zulu** (\$7.50) and **Postman Pat** (\$7.50) – while the other three – **Big Energy** (\$6), **Wow She's Fast** (\$7.50) and **Victa Damian** (\$9.50) are prepared by 'Team Greenough' (Jackie and Kel).

The sextet has a combined total of **148** starts for **91** wins (a 61% strike rate) with **\$3,410,160** in prizemoney. They have also won **four** G1s between them.

Quite simply, the Melbourne Cup heats are 'Fields of Dreams'!

Meanwhile, four heats of the Group 1 Sportsbet Bold Trease (715m) for the staying supremos will also be decided on the program.

Some of the major players ultimately chasing a \$105,000 first prize are locals **Moraine Suzie** (reigning Victorian Stayer of the Year), **Zoha Bale** (dual G1 finalist) and **Like Wildfire** (G1 Topgun Stayers finalist), along with New South Wales star **Palawa King** (winner G1 National Distance Championship and G1

Queensland Cup) and Queensland staying revelation **Icy Eyes** (12 wins from 22 starts including past six in succession) who heads Sportsbet's 'All In' market at \$4.

Saturday night's Melbourne Cup heats meeting, and the remainder of the Dream Chasers Festival, will be showcased nationally on free-to-air television on Racing.com, as well as Foxtel's channel 529.

Be on course on any of the three remaining nights of the Sportsbet Dream Chasers Festival for a chance to share in more than \$100,000 in cash and prizes.

This Saturday night, simply head to the Sportsbet tent at Sandown Park and scan the QR code before Race 5 (8.02pm) for your chance to be one of eight lucky patrons drawn and allocated a greyhound competing in Race 9 (9.25pm).

If your dog wins, you'll get to pick a box to reveal your prize from a pool including \$10k cash or \$5k fuel and grocery vouchers.

You must be on course to collect your prize.
