Group 1 Sportsbet Melbourne Cup: Armchair guide

After a near-record heat victory, **Big Energy** is hot favourite to win the 68th running of the \$1,008,000 Group 1 Sportsbet Melbourne Cup Final (515m) at Sandown Park on Saturday night.

Regarded as Australian greyhound racing's 'Holy Grail', the Melbourne Cup headlines the penultimate night of the second \$4.1 million Dream Chasers Festival, which concludes with the third edition of The Phoenix at The Meadows on Saturday 16 December.

Trained by Kel and Jackie Greenough at Pearcedale, **Big Energy (box 4)** is striving to complete a scintillating clean-sweep of the Sandown legs of the five-week Dream Chasers Festival.

The track specialist secured his first group trophy when winning the fourgreyhound G3 Shootout (515m) on November 18, before clocking the fastest time in last Saturday's eight 'must win' heats, smashing the elusive 29-seconds barrier on both occasions.

Big Energy's 28.91sec heat performance was the fifth quickest time recorded at Sandown, eclipsed by only track record holder Aston Rupee (twice), champion kennelmate Wow She's Fast and 2020 Melbourne Cup hero Hard Style Rico.

As a result, Big Energy dominates Sportsbet's Melbourne Cup market at \$1.85. The second elect at \$4.60 is the second fastest heat winner, **Tim Zoo (box 7)**.

Tim Zoo, named after world light middle-weight boxing champion Tim Tszyu, is trained by champion mentor Jason Thompson, who like the Greenoughs, is also based at Pearcedale.

Thompson is striving to become the first trainer to win the Cup on four occasions, having won the race with Light Of Fire (1994), Got A Moment (2012) and Black Magic Opal (2013), while wife Seona was victorious with Aston Dee Bee (2017).

The only other finalist at single figures in betting is **Buddy Monelli (box 1)**, trained by Lyn Smith, at \$5 after a 29.44sec heat victory where the former Western Australian also had the advantage of the rails alley.

A total of \$1,398,385 in prizemoney will be distributed on the bumper Cup card.

The meeting also features the \$165,500 G1 Sportsbet Bold Trease (715m), \$42,875 G3 Sir John Dillon Memorial (595m), \$42,875 G3 Sportsbet Cup Night Sprint (515m), \$42,875 G3 Provincial Plate (515m) and \$22,000 Listed Sportsbet Cup Night Stayers (715m).

Melbourne Cup night will be showcased nationally on free-to-air television on Racing.com, as well as Foxtel's channel 529.

POINTS OF INTEREST:

- Champion Pearcedale trainer Jason Thompson Tim Zoo (Box 7) is chasing his fourth Melbourne Cup, having saluted with Light Of Fire (1994), Got A Moment (2012) and Black Magic Opal (2013). His wife, Seona, won the race with Aston Dee Bee (2017). Jason finished second with Hanify's Impact (2008) and third with See You Later (2005), Nitro Burst (2008), Hooked on Scotch (2019) and Plaintiff (2022). Seona also finished second with Black Opium (2018).
- Tom Dailly Fabs Vegetable (Box 2) forms part of 'Team Dailly' with wife Andrea who has won the Melbourne Cup twice Dyna Tron (2011) and Dyna Double One (2015). In fact, Andrea quinellaed a memorable final in 2015 with Fernando Bale finishing second. Andrea was also

runner-up with **Dyna Lachlan** (2009), **Dyna Beth** (2013) and **Lala Kiwi** (2021) and third with **Hawk Alone** (2013).

- Paul Bartolo **Make No Promise** (Box 8) quinellaed the Melbourne Cup in 2006 with litter sisters **Betty's Angel** and **Miss Mini Mouse**.
- There are two female trainers in this year's final: Lyn Smith Buddy Monelli (Box 1) and Jackie Greenough - Big Energy (Box 4). Jackie's husband, Kel, finished third with Tommy Shelby (2020). The most recent female trainer to win a Melbourne Cup is Andrea Dailly with Dyna Double One (2015).
- Only two female greyhounds have won the Melbourne Cup in the past 20 years **Betty's Angel (**2006) and **Got A Moment** (2012). **Idolize** is looking to buck the trend.
- During the past two decades only four favourites have won the sport's 'Holy Grail' – 2003 Bombastic Shiraz (\$2.30), 2010 El Grand Senor (\$1.70), 2013 Black Magic Opal (\$2.00) and 2017 Aston Dee Bee (\$2.40).
- The longest-priced winner in this period is **Ando's Mac** (\$12.90) in 2016.
- Hard Style Rico (\$5.70) established a race record (28.91sec) in 2020.
- 2018 Melbourne Cup winner My Redeemer is the sire of **Idolize** (Box 6).
- Meanwhile, stud supremo and 2015 Melbourne Cup runner-up Fernando Bale (2015) has two finalists – Mac's Damage (Box 3) and Make No Promise (Box 8).
- And sire Aussie Infrared also has dual representation **Big Energy** (Box 4) and **Tim Zoo** (Box 7).
